



Application for a Special Exhibition

Special Exhibitions may consist of the work of one artist; of a small group (2-6 persons); of artist associations; and/or of curated exhibitions.

All Proposals must include the following:

- A CD of jpg/jpeg images intended to be or represent the artwork to be hung in the proposed exhibition. For a single artist, a minimum of 12 – 15; for a small group, a minimum of 6-8 for each artist; for a larger group, a minimum of 3-5 for each artist (or the number of works to be shown by each artist); and for a curated show, a minimum of 2-3 for each artist (or the specific works to be shown).
- A printed list of the artworks shown on the CD which includes the name, media, size, date, and price of each
- A printed cv or resume with contact information.
- A printed artist's statement about the work and about the concept or theme of the exhibition.

For larger groups/art associations, we require that the proposals contain artwork that has been juried.

Proposal CDs and paper information will not be returned.

The Proposals may be sent at any time. The Gallery Director and Selection Committee will review all proposals and inform all applicants as to their acceptance or rejection in February of each year. All decisions of the Director and Committee are final.
